

The Jew gave us a sitting and his turban and a part of his dress were finished. In the evening we left by train for Ghatcooper [Ghatkopar] 12 miles from Bombay. We put up at a temporary shed erected for us in a big compound belonging to a Parsee gentlemen [sic]. The night was extremely cold. Ghatkopar is daily becoming more crowded owing to the plague in the city.

F rida~ 8th F ebruar~ J 901

The morning extremely cold. Our servants could not sleep owing to the cold. In the afternoon we went to Bombay and tried to paint the Jews at Dr Mathai's but the light was very bad and so could not make any progress. Returned to Ghatkopar at about 8 p.m. The evening very cold.

5aturda~ 9th F ebruar~ J 90 J

In the afternoon Brother, Shriram and I went to Mumbra and made a sketch of the 'Bawnmalang' Hill [Bava Malang Hill] lighted

by the setting sun. We have to go again to finish the sketch but as there are no convenient trains for the return journey there is some difficulty. We had to wait for 2 hours to catch the train.

5unda~ 10th F ebruar~ J 901

The Jew came and we painted him in the afternoon. I have a severe cold and cough and the cool wind that blows here (Ghatcooper) makes them worse. Our shed too is not quite air tight. There is more ventilation than is agreeable.

Monda~ 1 J th F ebruar~ 1 901

The Jew came again to sit; we painted his head. Settled his accounts and dismissed him. I got severe attack of fever in the evening. I spent a restless night. No medical aid is available near at hand. To morrow we shall call Dr Mathai from Bombay.

T uesda~ 12th F ebruar~ J 901

My temperature was nearly 103 and [I] felt shivering with cold. Dr Mathai to whom intimation of my illness had been given called. I have severe cough too, but neither headache nor pain on the chest. Dr left for Bombay at about 10. p.m. Shriram, for Karli a little later.

Wednesda~ 1)th Februar~ J 901

I had no fever in the morning and throughout the afternoon but in the evening shivering commenced and fever rose to 102[.] Dr Mathai called at
