"Talking Pictures in India" by Willard Van Dyke



"With one exception, I have been privileged to be the only American directly connected with the Indian Film Industry and under my supervision was produced India's first sound and talking picture.

"During the fall of 1930, the possibility of producing sound pictures was first suggested by one of the leading producers of Bombay, and arrangements completed for securing contracts. I sailed from Los Angeles harbour on what promised at least an interesting round the world trip, little expecting the momentous events which followed. Knowing nothing of Indian procedure or production methods, no advance plans were made.

"My arrival in Bombay and subsequent period of life amidst the luxuries of the East showered upon me shall ever be remembered. Roy L suites...servants...cars...all were mine! Seven lived such a Potemkin! But above all, the opportunity to achieve was freely and fully given, and every facility made available.





"A Survey of India, predicting methods
provided quite a shock, and quite
undermined my confidence in motion picture,
extending over eight years. This was being
successively applied to film that would
last in black and white, staged
consisting of living creatures surrounded by
glass or celluloid or covering, the greater
part of which, with a few small and usually
and boring holes, contained the tiers of
photographic apparatus. Then came the
ulitest traps - for fundamental facts were
evident. The laboratory processing methods
available at that time were still deteriorating,
an obviously the greatest problem. Even
today this problem exists, though the past
year has seen substantial progress. Satisfactory
solutions have always been more difficult to
achieve.

"After exposure, the film is wound on reels
holding about 150 feet, and it will point
roughly back-to-with a loss of as much ten frames.
These reels are then developed and passed through
the successive stages of increasing, until
each frame which has been processed and dried is a

sufficient moisture in being down to
temperature to 35 degrees... If a
frozen film temperature of 20 degrees
with a humidity exceeding 90%, naturally
the ice melts rapidly, diluting the
solution of the bath, so that in the
procession of the given magazine of the
film, it is impossible to ensure consistent
exposure over the appreciable length. It is
of paramount importance therefore
regarding film to be considered. Furthermore,
now at present of all film news even been
considered, and eliminating, negative film
was accepted as most, owing to the
negative form which did away with any and
ordinary bubbles in the emulsion, caused by
the racks of film being collected about in
the film tanks, were immediate problems to
be considered before attempting production
of second pictures. That is to say 'the moment'

"A director recently went to America
India, mainly to study of a Hollywood
production, he decidedly bad "experience"
proved that all but the requisites for
film-making were superfluous. Artists
and Indian connections are very

"Hollywood is in a painful condition
of too much 'fairy' in studio

Discord of Tongues

The market of the Indian producer, up to this hour, had been an area inhabited by several hundred million people. Burmese and Ceylon were being administered at present in India and within this area no barriers—political, economic, or linguistic—barred the way to Indian films. Decadal success has gone to Mysore, East Africa, South Africa. But now a film world appears which is large enough in Bombay, what is it lacking in production volume, to count? Located in the Marathi-speaking area of the country, its producers would naturally make films in that language. If so, they would at the start of the 1940's have a potential market of 21 million people scattered in the good agricultural Bombay and Madras, Poona, Andhra, and other cities. But the film would be incomprehensible in the rest of India, in Burma, and in Ceylon.

In Calcutta, which stands second in production, if a market is situated in Bengal, its producers would naturally make films in the Bengali language, which would give them a market area inhabited by some 35 million people in the northeastern portion of India again, the film would be incomprehensible in most other parts of India, in Burma, and in Ceylon.

In Madras, which had made a hesitant start in film production to secure this strength in the Tamil-speaking area of the country, its producers would logically make films in that language, which could give them a potential market area of 20 million people in southern India and some additional millions in Ceylon, Madras, and Africa. But the Tamil, anyway, in Dravidian descent and unrelated to Marathi, Bengali, and other northern Indian tongues, would make the films incomprehensible in most of India.

World film producers accustomed to visions of wide, growing markets may be bemused into linguistic pockets instead of coming to a large area which develops from census and equal in-

100 items and on March 4, 1931, put on a program of 31 songs. They included a hymn chanted in Sanskrit, a "wayward singer at the temple of love," a girl's school thesis, singing a "gong song," a dance by "the Gomti-gan girl," a scene from a Hindi Ramlila play, a recitation from Kahlil Gibran's "Screams of the Heart" (see p. 11), a speech by Indian Nobel Prize physicist Sir C. V. Raman, and other items including a comic song. On the same day a Bombay producer, the Imperial Film Company, began the first recording of feature-length film "Beauty of the World." A number of Madras tea plantation songs in Bengali and Tamil dialect followed this, and, subsequently, eight Madras features were released in 1931, another in 1932. But the impetus left, and it did not end. In the following year, during a short time, 140 pictures were made. The demand was so great for equipment that other producers had to turn to old European or the existing Chinese. The Madras film industry has not yet had a chance.






The story of 'Alam Ara', the first Indian talkie film, is woven around the two queens - Nawabazar and Gulzar - of the King of Jaunpur. Both were childless. ... Gulzar's prediction that a son will be born to Ravabazar's wives Dilbar, who hates the king for his devotion to his second queen, Leela. Gulzar has designs on Adil, the army chief. When she is shamed by him, she gets him imprisoned and his wife banished. Adil's wife dies while giving birth to Alam Ara.

A charm around Alam Ara's neck reveals that she is the daughter of Adil. One night she secretly leaves the nomad camp where she has been brought up and goes to the palace to seek her father's release. In the palace she encounters the young prince (Nawabazar's son) who falls in love with her.

In the final sequence, the
nobles return to the city in triumph.
They are paid to release the father's
relatives, return their lands, and now
to enter the dungeon where Alain is
imprisoned. Just when Villon's entourage
wanting to give Alain his last chance
of returning home, Villon and
relatives, she gets irritated and is
about to kill him when Alain rushes
out of his hiding place. So do the
king and his party. Villon is
exposed, is arrested, and is imprisoned

"About a year before I sat upon
producing 'Alain-Rescued', I had seen
universal pictures' 'showboat', a com-
edy, at Accademy. It gave me an
idea to make an Indian comedy film.
But we had no experience and no
inspiration to follow. Anyhow, we
decided to go ahead."

we could ill afford, so I took upon
myself the recording of the film with
help from Charlie.

"We had no music director for the film.
I chose the lyrics on the spot, as
used only a harmonium and a guitar
player, who was out of town today,

and this is now being taken into account.

This is a most difficult film because it took complete advantage of the hazards of sound recording under very trying conditions. Besides, we had to be very careful not to disclose the fact that we were actually talking. It was a closely guarded secret.

"The film cost us only about Rs. 15,000 - half in co-operation of the artists and citizens who shared my excitement regarding the first Indian talkie. The film was a tremendous success when released on March 16, 1931 at the Majestic Cinema. The theatre was packed and tickets were all available for next. The blackmarketeers made a fortune. Almost all the songs were hits, particularly the one sung by **... KED** (who played the role of the Lakkur).





first film star

The search is now on for the next big star of Indian cinema, to star with the Indian "Laramie Kid," now being made here by quite soon, according to Mr. David Shulman, who arrived in the mainland on Friday. Already there is some interest in the job, with stars having been engaged in England and even before the party started for India.



THE THREAT TO ELEPHANTA

ELEPHANTA is very much in the public eye just now, and it is evident that repair to the carvings and images executed by a master by the Archaeological Department of the Government of India are meeting with considerable criticism. The three sketches which were recently exhibited by Mr. Olafursson Salomon at Blenheim, show the nature of the work which is being done. The sketch on the left is the figure of the Goddess Durga, from the group of Shiva passing over Mount Kailasa upon the Deafan King Ravana. The renovation is shown in the black spaces which do not avoid the stone or conform to the modelling of the figure. The sketch on the right shows what remains of the figure of Ravana with the cracks filled in with stone cement which certainly does not improve the look of the sculpture.

The opinion has been expressed that there is power, and others which have reasonably been carried out, are superficial and unsightly. Other images have been treated in this crude manner. In the group to the right of the Trimurti there is a roughly machined surface running diagonally downwards through the figure of Parvati. The sword blade in the Bhairava group and the weapon in the Trident group have been similarly defaced. In the case of the disappearance of parts of the Trimurti has been caused behind the right shoulder and cannot be stopped with stone cement in a way which will certainly not prevent the arms from coming down.

Critics affirm that these and other repairs should have been overseen by a highly cast metal worker and have
