



Thursda~ 28thjul~ J 898-Aud~ 1+

Schleicher [+++] and Girhardt [Gerhardt] went in the morning to Karli for a change. I went to the market in the afternoon and thence to the Fort where I gave my watch to be repaired to R. Langner, Watchmaker and returned home via market. Doctor went to Shivaji's house to ask if he could find out suitable lodging for him, but returned unsuccessful.

Frida~ 29thjul~ 1898-Aud~ 15

This morning I called on Dr Balachandra and he told me that the whole amount I wanted is ready and whenever I require it he would pay. In the afternoon I called first on Ms Loundy[?] and sent H.H. one music book as it was difficult to make a selection. At Whiteaway and Laidlaw's, I bought a pillow, shirt and in the evening two detectives called on me and asked me if I could give them any information about one Shriram Sashtri who swindled some people at Vizagapatnam and Cumbakonam saying he was a graduate and so on.

This morning I went to Govardhan Das and introduced Dr to him. He said he would prepare release at once and enable me to leave on Tuesday when he himself intended going either to Calcutta or Bangalore. Went to Shivaji's. [Before going to Shivaji's went to Jacob circle by tram, but it was difficult to find any road without a doctor]. Went to Shivaji's house and visited the house for the doctor but it was dirty and so had to give up. Returned home at 6.

In the afternoon I received a visit from Rajibai and Laxmibai who came to take leave of me having heard I was leaving on Wednesday. Mr Govardhan Das promised to let the release [be] ready anyhow tomorrow. Called on Dr Balachandra in the evening. Pillai Doctor and I went to Apollo Bunder for a walk. Bapuji came at night.

Monda~ J st August 1 8 9 8-Aud~ 1 8

Narat[?] Purnima.99 The streets of Bombay and the sea-shore thronged by crowd[?] of gaily attired people. There was a fair opposite the Municipal Office. I went to see it with Kasi; but the crowd was so great that I had to return without seeing much of it. At night I got the drafts at last.

**T**uesda~ 2nd August J 898-Aud~ 19

Early in the morning I went to Mr Bapuji and next to Bai Jivanji who proposed certain alterations. It was approved by us and signed in the evening
