The first time my brother and myself left Travancore on professional work was in 1878 when we were invited to Pudukota [Pudukkottai] by the late Raja at the instruction of Ms Sesthriasastri. My brother had accompanied by one of his cousins and brother-in-law undertaken a pilgrimage to Mukambika Temple on the West Coast of Malabar in 1870. This was the
